## Vibrant Cardigan

## GAUGE

Each square measures 14 cm aprox using a 5 mm hook
ABBREVIATIONS (UK)

| sl st | Slip stitch |
| :--- | :--- |
| ch | Chain |
| tr | Treble crochet |
| sp | Space |
| round | Rnd |

## NOTES:

Cardigan is made up of 48 squares and two half squares to shape the neck. All the squares follow the same pattern. However, there are 9 colour groups where you will need to work the classic pattern in a different way.
There are 4 rounds that make up the square. These will be worked using different colour combinations but the last row- 5th- will be worked in the same colour for all the squares.
16 squares make up the back panel, 8 squares and 1 half square form one front panel and 9 squares are needed for one sleeve. Once these panels are created, they will be then joined- using whipstitch- to assemble the cardigan.
The pattern is written in one size that could fit from Small to Large sizes. However, you could add squares (to make it bigger) or take squares (to make it smaller) to adapt this design to your body and preferences.
After assembling the cardigan, a border will be worked around the two fronts and the back to create an impeccable finish.

## PATTERN:

SQUARE 1 (MAKE 6)
With Yarn B, chain 4. Join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.
Rnd 1: 3ch (counts as 1 tr here and throughout), 2 tr in ring, $2 \mathrm{ch},(3 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{ch}$ ) three times in ring, join with sl st to top of 3 ch .
Rnd 2: 4ch (counts as 1 tr and 1 ch ), *(3tr, 2ch, 3tr) in first 2ch-sp, 1 ch* repeat from * twice more, (3tr, 2ch, 2tr) in last 2ch-sp, sl st to 3rd ch from initial 4ch. Fasten off.
Rnd 3: Attach Yarn C to any 2ch-corner sp, 3ch, (2tr, 2ch, 3tr), 1ch, 3tr in sp between 3 tr groups, 1 ch , * $3 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ ) in $2 \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ in sp between 3 tr groups, 1 ch * repeat from * twice more, sl st to top of 3ch. Fasten off.
Rnd 4: Attach Yarn D to any 2ch-corner sp, 3ch, (2tr, 2ch, 3tr), 1ch, 3tr in sp between 3tr groups, 1ch, 3tr in next 1ch-sp, 1ch, *(3tr, 2ch, 3tr) in 2ch-sp, $1 \mathrm{ch},\left(3 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{ch}\right.$ ) in each $1 \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}$ to next corner $2 \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}^{*}$ repeat from *twice more, sl st to top of 3ch. Fasten off.
Rnd 5: Attach Yarn A to any 2ch-corner sp, 3ch, (2tr, 2ch, 3tr), 1ch, 3tr in sp between 3tr groups, 1ch, *(3tr, 1ch) in next 1ch-sp* repeat from * once more, *(3tr, 2ch, 3tr) in next 2ch-sp, 1ch, (3tr, 1ch) in each sp to next corner 2ch-sp* repeat from *twice more, sl st to top of 3ch. Fasten off.

SQUARE 2 (MAKE 4)
Repeat instructions for square 1 using Yarn $A, E, F$ and $I$.
Rnd 1: Yarn F
Rnd 2: Yarn F
Rnd 3: Yarn E
Rnd 4: Yarn I
Rnd 5: Yarn A

SQUARE 3 (MAKE 2)
Repeat instructions for square 1 using Yarn A, C, E and F
Rnd 1: Yarn C
Rnd 2: Yarn C
Rnd 3: Yarn F
Rnd 4: Yarn E
Rnd 5: Yarn A

SQUARE 4 (MAKE 2)
Repeat instructions for square 1 using Yarn A, B, E and F
Rnd 1: Yarn B
Rnd 2: Yarn B
Rnd 3: Yarn F
Rnd 4: Yarn E
Rnd 5: Yarn A

## SQUARE 5 (MAKE 8)

With Yarn I, chain 4. Join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.
Rnd 1: 3ch (counts as 1tr here and throughout), 2tr in ring, 2ch, (3tr, 2ch) three times in ring, join with sl st to top of 3ch. Fasten off.
Rnd 2: Attach Yarn F to any 2ch-corner sp, 3ch, (2tr, 2ch, 3tr), 1ch, *(3tr, 2ch, 3 tr ) in $2 \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}, 1 \mathrm{ch}$ * repeat from * twice more, sl st to top of 3 ch . Fasten off.
Rnd 3: As Rnd 3 from square 1 using Yarn E
Rnd 4: As Rnd 4 from square 1 using Yarn H
Rnd 5: As Rnd 5 from square 1 using Yarn A
SQUARE 6 (MAKE 6)
Repeat instructions for square 5 using Yarn A, D, E, H and I.
Rnd 1: Yarn H
Rnd 2: Yarn I
Rnd 3: Yarn E
Rnd 4: Yarn D
Rnd 5: Yarn A
SQUARE 7 (MAKE 6)
Repeat instructions for square 5 using Yarn A, B, G, H and I.
Rnd 1: Yarn H
Rnd 2: Yarn I
Rnd 3: Yarn G
Rnd 4: Yarn B
Rnd 5: Yarn A

## SQUARE 8 (MAKE 7)

With Yarn G, chain 4. Join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.
Rnd 1: As Rnd 1 from square 5.
Rnd 2: As Rnd 2 from square 5 using Yarn B. Do NOT fasten off at the end of the round. Continue with Yarn B.
Rnd 3: 4ch (counts as 1 tr and 1 ch ), *(3tr, 2ch, 3 tr ) in 2ch-sp, 1ch, 3 tr in sp between 3tr groups, 1ch* repeat from* twice more, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) in last 2ch-sp, 1ch, 2tr in last sp between 3tr groups, sl st to 3rd ch from initial 4ch. Fasten off.
Rnd 4: As Rnd 4 from square 5 using Yarn C.
Rnd 5: As Rnd 5 from square 5 using Yarn A.

SQUARE 9 (MAKE 7)
Repeat instructions for square 8 using Yarn A, C, F and G.
Rnd 1: Yarn C
Rnd 2: Yarn F
Rnd 3: Yarn F
Rnd 4: Yarn G
Rnd 5: Yarn A
HALF GRANNY SQUARE- MAKE 2
With Yarn B, chain 4. Join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.
Row 1: 3 ch (counts as 1 tr ), ( $2 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ ) into ring, turn.
Row 2: 3ch, 2 tr in same sp, 1 ch , miss 2 tr , ( $3 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ ) in 2ch-sp, 1 ch , miss $2 \mathrm{tr}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ into top of 3 ch at beg of previous row, turn.
Row 3: 3ch, 2 tr in same sp, 1ch, 3tr between 3tr groups, 1 ch , ( $3 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ ) in 2ch-sp, 1ch, 3tr between 3tr groups, 1ch, 3tr into top of 3ch at beg of previous row, turn. Change to Yarn C.
Row 4: 3ch, 2 tr in same $\mathrm{sp}, 1 \mathrm{ch}$, (3tr, 1 ch ) in each 1 ch -sp to next corner 2ch-sp, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) in 2ch-sp, 1ch, *(3tr, 1ch) between 3tr groups to last 1 ch-sp, 3tr into top of 3ch at beg of previous row, turn. Change to Yarn A.
Row 5: As Row 4 using Yarn A. Do NOT turn at the end of the row, continue working alongside the edge in rounds. $2 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ in same sp to make a corner, 1ch, *(3tr, 1ch) in each sp* repeat from * three times, 3tr, 2ch in same 3 tr space from previous row, sl st to top of 3 ch . Fasten off

## ASSEMBLE

Following Layout 1, join motifs to create back, front and sleeves panels. Join squares by sewing the edges together using Yarn A- hold squares with their RS together and whipstitch each st through both loops. Sew up fronts to back to create shoulders, joining only one square and leaving half square unworked. Attach sleeves to body and sew up sides.

## EDGE FOR BACK, RIGHT AND LEFT FRONT

Row 1: Join Yarn A to left side top corner, 3ch, 1tr in corner 2ch-sp, 1ch, work 3tr in space between each 3tr group to bottom of Left Front, (3tr, 2ch, 3 tr) in corner 2ch-sp, work around bottom edge in the same way ending at neck edge of Right Front ending with 2tr in last corner 2ch-sp. Do NOT turn. Fasten off.
Row 2: Working on Right side, attach Yarn B to Left side top corner. 4ch (counts as 1tr, 1ch), 3tr in each sp between groups, 1ch, working (3tr, 2ch, 3 tr ) in each corner 2 ch -sp, 1 tr in top of last tr. Do NOT turn. Fasten off.
Continue in this way working two more rows
Row 3: Using Yarn A as Row 1
Row 4: Using Yarn C as Row 2

## EDGE FOR CUFFS

Rnd 1: Attach Yarn A to any 1ch- sp, 3ch, work 3tr in each 3tr group, 1tr in each 1ch- sp, sl st to top of 3ch. Do NOT turn. Fasten off.
Rnd 2: As Rnd 1 using Yarn B. Fasten off.

## WASHING ADVICE

- Always wash in as warm a water temperature as possible - up to the temperature recommended, with a short spin. Use a lot of water if hand washing. For darker colours we recommend the use of discolouration sheets.
- Do not bleach
- Do not tumble dry. Drip-dry on a horizontal surface.
- Iron at a medium temperature using a damp cloth.
- Professional dry cleaning in tetrachloroethylene.
- Do not use optical brighteners (or any detergent containing optical brighteners).
