EXTRAS (for a necklace and a bracelet):

Pins

2x wooden beads: 1 cm Ø

4x split rings: 4 mm Ø

2x fastener: 1 cm Ø

2x end caps: 0,5 mm

1x Chain: ca. 15 cm

## Cosmopolitan necklace and bracelet set

### ABBREVIATIONS:

**ch** - chain stitch, **dc** - double crochet, **rep** – repeat, **sl st** - slip stitch, **st(s)** – stitch(es) - **tch** - turning chain

**Notes:** These necklace and bracelet are made with individual cords crocheted using the I-cord technique. The cords are joined together by crocheting and connected with chains of ch to form the them. The ends of the cords are provided with an end cap into which split rings, the fastener and the chain are threaded.

### HOW TO MAKE A I-CORD:

Crochet in rows. Make a chain of ch 4 (step 1). Crochet from the second ch from the hook.

**Row 1:** Slip into the 1st ch and pull the thread. This will form the 1st loop. Slip in the next ch and pick up the thread one at a time. There are now 4 loops on the hook (step 2).

**Row 2:** Squeeze the stitches tightly between your fingers and now pull the hook out of the last three loops. Be careful not to let this loop unravel while it is off the hook (step 3). Slip the thread through the loop remaining on the needle. Take the next loop on the hook and pull the thread through. Rep this also for the next 2 loops (step 4). Now there are 4 new loops on the hook.

Rep the 2nd row (step 5) until you have a 33 cm long I-cord for the necklace and until it fits loosely around the wrist for the bracelet. To fasten off at the end, slip the thread through all the loops on the hook and secure with a sl st. Crochet 5 cords in your favourite colours. Cut the threads, fasten off and weave ends in.



### APPLY THE FASTENER (ONLY FOR THE NECKLACE) :

Insert the hook in the center of the upper side of the beginning of the necklace and join with 1 sl st. Make a chain of ch 50 (step 11). Pull the thread tight at the end and cut long. Rep at the other end of the necklace. Thread a wooden bead onto each chain (step 12). Weave all threads in. Thread a split ring into the last ch at the end of each chain. Thread the chain fastener into one of the rings (step 13). Alternatively, the chain can be knotted in the neck without a fastener.



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#### APPLY THE FASTENER (ONLY FOR THE BRACELETS):

Now glue a cap to each end of the cords. After the glue has dried, attach a split ring to each end cap. Thread a chain and (optionally) a charm into one split ring. Attach the fastener to the other split ring.



#### WASHING ADVICE

- Always wash in as warm a water temperature as possible - up to the temperature recommended, with a short spin. Use a lot of water if hand washing. For darker colours we recommend the use of discolouration sheets.
- Do not bleach.
- Do not tumble dry. Drip-dry on a horizontal surface.
- Iron at a medium temperature using a damp cloth.
- Professional dry cleaning in tetrachloroethylene.
- Do not use optical brighteners (or any detergent containing optical brighteners).
