TENSION:

16 sts and 14 rnds = 10 X 10 cm (in htr, worked in round) after blocking.

STITCHES AND ABBREVIATIONS

ch/s: chain/s

sl st: slip stitch

dc: double crochet

dc2tog: double crochet 2 sts together (do not fasten off the last loop of every st, then yo and fasten off all loops on hook)

htr: half treble

htr2tog: half treble crochet 2 sts together (do not fasten off the last loop of every st, then yo and fasten off all loops on hook)

htrBL: half treble crochet worked in the back loop

htrBL2tog: half treble crochet 2 sts together worked in the back loop

htrFL: half treble crochet worked in the front loop

long sl st: insert hook through magic ring, pull up a longer loop and then pull through the loop on your hook, completing your sl st.

rep: repeat

rnd/s: Round/s

tr: treble

tr2tog: treble crochet 2 sts together (do not fasten off the last loop of every st, then yo and fasten off all loops on hook)

st/s: stitch/es

surface ch: insert hook through any of the sts from the previous rnd, pull up a loop, * insert hook in next st, pull up a loop then pull through the loop on your hook, completing your sl st *, rep *.

WS: wrong side

INSTRUCTIONS

The hat starts with flower squares that are joined together to form the central strip. On each side of the central strip, 3 rnds of double crochet are worked and the top of the hat is worked on one side and the brim of the hat is worked on the opposite side.

FLOWERS SQUARES

Make 6 flower squares, three starting with colour A (dark center) and three starting with colour C (light center). Rnds 3 and 6 are always worked in colour B, using surface crochet technique, in chain stitch. The chart is always the same.

Colour A (C), make a magic ring and start following **Chart 1**. Work rnd 1 e 2 in colour A (C). Cut yarn. Using colour B, make the surface chs of rnd 3, cut yarn and pull through last st.

Using colour C (A), make the sts of rnd 4 in the sts of rnd 2 and continue with rnd 5. Cut yarn. Using colour B make surface chs of rnd 6 in the sts of rnd 5 or in the st of rnd 4 indicated by the arrow. Cut yarn and pull through last st. Using colour A (C), make sts of rnd 7 in sts of rnd 5. Cut yarn (60 sts). Each side of the square has 13 sts and 2 chs in each corner.

CENTRAL STRIP

JOIN SQUARES

Join squares with the centers of different colors alternately to form the central strip, whose ends will be joined to make the circumference of the head.

STRIP SIDES

Work both sides of the central strip the same way, in rnd with colour B. Start in any of the sts of one of the squares.

Rnd 1: 1 ch (does not count as st throughout), dc in each next st and in each ch corner space until the end of the rnd, join. (90 sts).

Rnds 2-3: 1 ch, dc to end, join.

TOP OF HAT - CHART 2

On top side of central strip, start working **Chart 2**, in any of the sts with colour A. Repeat the pattern 9 times.

Work the 11 rnds and in the end, cut yarn, leaving a long tail to close the gap, using a tapestry needle weave the tail into each of the 9 sts around and pull tightly to close. Fasten off on WS.

BRIM - CHART 3

On bottom side of central strip in any of the sts start working **Chart 3** with colour C and work six rnds, the last rnd (rnd 7) is worked with colour A. Repeat the pattern 9 times. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block.

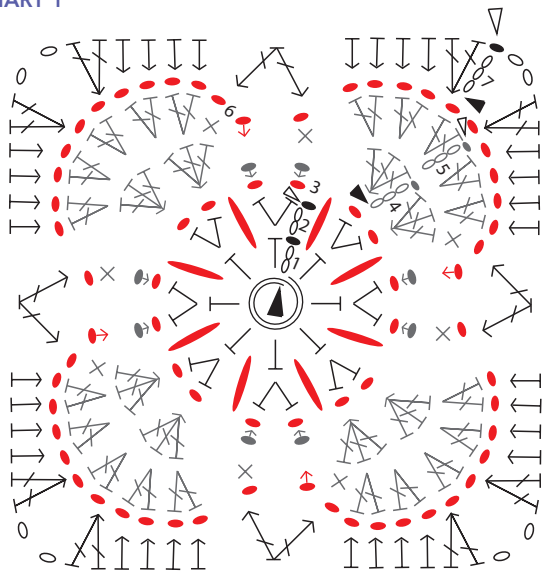
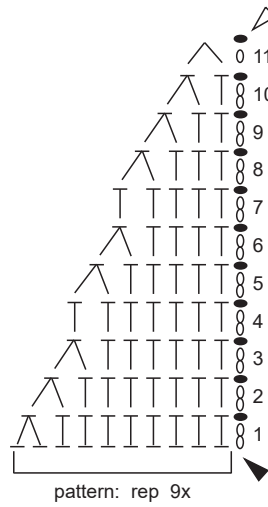

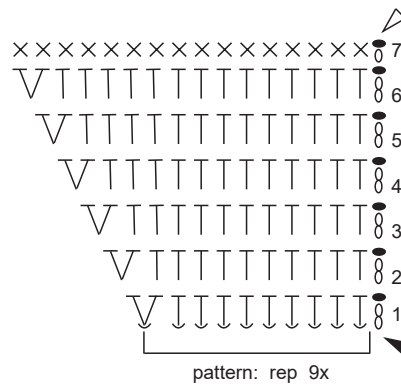

WASHING ADVICE

- Always wash in as warm a water temperature as possible - up to the temperature recommended (up to 30°C), with a short spin. Use a lot of water if hand washing. For darker colours we recommend the use of discolouration sheets.
- Do not bleach.
- Do not tumble dry. Lay flat to dry away from direct sunlight.
- Iron at a low temperature using a damp cloth.
- Professional dry cleaning in tetrachloroethylene.
- Do not use optical brighteners (or any detergent containing optical brighteners).
